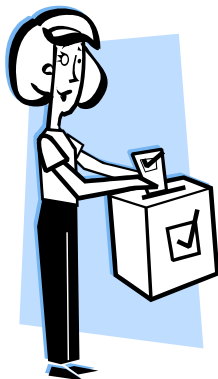

Please ensure that MORNA has your correct & current address. These addresses are submitted at the beginning of each year to Clockwork. If the journal is considered undeliverable, the cover is ripped off and the journal is discarded by Canada Post. The cover is then delivered back to the publisher with a C.O.D. charge of \$0.65 for each cover. ORNAC pays for all returned journals decreasing final profits. Any changes of address also need to be submitted as soon as possible to prevent any delays in subsequent mailings. WRHA News Alert!

Did you know!

1. Since the last newsletter you may have seen some changes at your site. (Just in case you haven't noticed)
 - New WRHA History and Physical Forms for patients coming for surgery.
 - Obstructive Sleep Apnea (OSA) Risk Assessment Guidelines and Post op standing orders.
 - WRHA Informed Consent Form and Refusal of Treatment Form.
 - Learning packages and forms are available on the external WRHA site. www.wrha.mb.ca Click on Professionals, Family Physicians, Surgery Program.
2. The WRHA Surgery Program in collaboration with Diagnostic Services Manitoba (DSM) has developed a new policy "Pathology Specimens – Acute Care Setting (Management of). DSM also has a Specimens Acceptance Policy.
 - A learning package is being developed that will address both policies.
 - Along with the above policies, DSM will be implementing new WRHA Pathology Requisitions.
 - Watch for additional information and educational sessions in the near future.
3. The WRHA OR Educators are working on standardized guidelines for Surgical Skin Preps. Watch for these guidelines and educational sessions in the near future.
4. Medical Device Reprocessing (MDR) update:
 - A Loaner Instrumentation Policy is being worked on with input from MDR, ORs, surgeons, vendors, and those responsible for finances.
 - Current Emergency "Flash" sterilization practices are being reviewed to identify areas for improvement therefore having practices more consistent with CSA standards.
 - In collaboration with the Anesthesia Program and IP&C practices for cleaning of laryngoscope handles and blades is being standardized.
 - The 2nd Annual MDR Workshop is being planned for June 29 and 30, 2009. Watch for details coming soon.

- On Saturday November 15th an Endoscopy Specialist Training Course for nurses and MDR staff was held. The course was sponsored by Olympus with 58 participants and 8 observers attending. A great deal of learning took place and interest was expressed in providing another course in the future.

5. Perioperative Orientation Session Trivia:

- 58 nurses have participated in the Perioperative Orientation since July 2006. 14 are currently doing their clinical, 39 have successfully completed the Orientation and 5 did not complete (various reasons).
- An additional 6 nurses from the Pain Clinic successfully completed a modified orientation.
- Participants are from HSC (adult), HSC (children's), CH, VGH, GGH, SOGH, SBGH, Dauphin, Boundary Trails, Bethesda, Carmen, Altona, Portage, and HSC Pain Clinic.
- Modifications have been made to the Orientation to allow for additional participants in each session.
